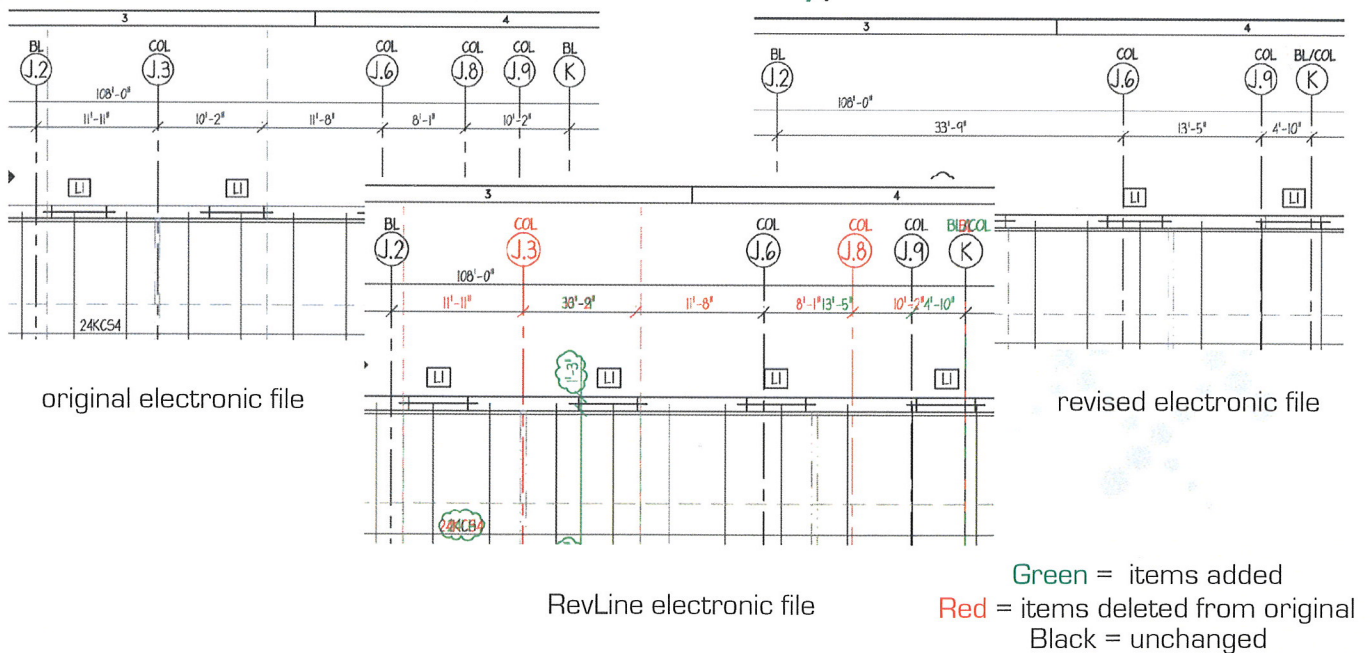


What is RevLine?

RevLine is a comparison tool in which changes to your electronic documents are identified. RevLine shows additions or deletions even if they are not bubbled or noted!

How Does it Work?

- Revision Sets – Highlighting Changes from one version to the next.
 - Supplemental Sets for Owner/GC/Sub/Engineer/Architect
 - Avoids **Mistakes**, Increases **Clarity**, Reduces **Time**



RevLine takes your original electronic file, compares it to the revised file, and creates a new electronic file showing all changes! **Red** items appearing on the document represent things that have been deleted from the original file, **green** items have added to the revised file, and **black** items have not been changed.

Why use RevLine?

Save time and money by increasing accuracy and protecting your company. Changes are clearly shown for fast results and error avoidance.

How do I use it?

Three simple steps:

1. Upload your file to our site via 'Send a Job' at www.digitalblue.com. One containing the original file and one containing the revision file in marked folders.
2. We will take your files and do a RevLine comparison for you.
3. Wait until you receive an email to download the comparison file.



How much does it cost?

If you want a digital file (PDF): \$5 per file compared (\$15 min.)

Hard copy prints are also available in half size or full size with our value color.

FAQ's

File formats acceptable for comparison are: PDF, DWF, TIFF, and HP-GL plot files.

It takes an original file and the revised file to make one compared RevLine file.

Some drawings may be muddy when overlapped, but do show you where to spend time clarifying changes.

If a file name is not readily apparent as to what should be compared and needs to be renamed it will result in a \$1 per file renaming fee.
